- 4. For Roll Number use this code: Prim20**

You will have seen another file in here called Chance week 1. It has a couple of worksheets you can work from. You can print it off if you have a printer or work from the screen. Either is great. You can put your answers in your Math's copy or on a sheet.

There are a couple of sheets here for you to do. You have to use your own words to say how likely it is that each thing will happen!! Use words like: Impossible, Unlikely, Even Chance, Likely, Certain.....or any other words you come up with. This sheet might take a bit of time so take a break when it is done! This worksheet is from Twinkl.

Thursday:

Revise 5x tables!! We like these ones. Do them forwards and backwards!

Mental Maths: Complete Wednesday and Thursday this week.

Friday:

Have a tables competition against someone at home. You quiz them or let them quiz you. Focus on 3x, 4x and 5x for this week. If you can, use your topmarks.co.uk and the Hit the button game. Time and keep a record of your score.

Mental Maths: Complete The Problem- Solving for this week. Pick 1 or 2 if you find them challenging. If not do as many as you want along with the Friday Review.
